

CROWN ON YOUR FRONT TEETH (Anterior Crowns)

There are two types of crowns that may be placed on your tooth.

1. Metal based crown with porcelain over it. This is called a PFM
2. All porcelain crowns

As we age or even just by preparing your tooth for a crown the gum will recede (pull back, appear lower). You may have seen a person with a crown on the front tooth that appears to have a black line. This black line is caused by the gum receding (pulling back) and the margin (bottom) of the crown showing. With all porcelain crowns as the gum recedes you will notice a difference in the color because the root color is different color but it will not appear as a black line.

If you need a crown because you had a root canal you also need a post

Please understand that once I place a metal post you cannot change your mind on the type of crown you desire.
